
I thought I would provide you with a written update in advance of our meeting this evening.

- 1. Nathan Strickland feedback loop completed last week at camp with hour-long session with our teens. Overall feedback from all groups was positive. Committee felt he interviewed well, similar feedback from Elders who provided feedback. Consistent feedback on needs were around Biblical base of knowledge, class delivery where he needs to improve and questions about his ability to lead versus being a hangout buddy for the teens. One of the teens said that they felt he had the personal characteristics to be successful but needed skills training to perform the role well which I think is an accurate summary.
- 2. I spoke with Jeremy at camp last week about his interest in the role. He wouldn't provide a definitive answer but did commit to giving me one by August 13.
- 3. We have our final candidate **coming in on the weekend of 8/20** for an interview, Wesley Handwork. Wesley interned this summer at Highland in Memphis, Ted Crigler's congregation. He also interned at Southwest in Jonesboro and comes highly recommended. His initial Zoom screen with the committee was quite strong and we felt it warranted bringing him in.
