2022 MX Priorities

Recommendation by Vision Elders and Senior Minister for discussion at Monday Elders' meeting, June 20th.

I. Current Status

- I. We have a good Mission Statement, 7 Values, and structure of Delight in God, Encourage One Another, Serve Eagerly as our broad desire for every member.
- II. Have secured Elder and staff agreement on key priorities: **Small Groups, Leadership/Ministry Leader Development and NexGen/Family, and Community Service.**
- III. Have working document and summary outline of communication (Don's letter).

II. Challenges

- I. Could feel a lot like business as usual.
- II. We need a memorable message a story to live by a hook to hang our hat on.
- III. Need to attract and get buy-in and ownership from a much wider swath of the church.
- IV. Consider reframing as most people, even our members, do not think in terms of what is best for the church. Their questions:
 - a. "Why has Jesus called me to service?"
 - b. "What's in it for me?"
 - c. "Do I belong at MX?"
 - d. "How do I succeed in life and take my family with me?"
 - e. "What is God's calling on my life?"
 - f. "I have as much or more going on as I want and need."

Our framing should be more kingdom and mission focused than church focused.

III. Next Steps

- I. Give a brief summary of our progress to the congregation on June 26th.
- II. **Conversations** Hold a series of weekly sessions during Bible Class in the near future to discuss our selected priorities, listen to one another, and create engagement.
 - a. Timing July 10 through August, or September 11-October.
 - b. Meet in gym, at tables, similar to inter-generational class.
 - c. Leadership provides the structure, reinforces the values, and lays out the priorities.
 - d. Prayer for the Holy Spirit to work in this open congregational setting.
 - e. Invite representation from young and old, new and old, and male and female.
 - f. From this conversation ministry ideas are generated and further defined.
 - g. Volunteers and Ministry Leaders are surfaced.
 - h. See engagement process as a "win" for the kingdom.
- III. Extend invitations for members to join elders on Sundays at 8:30.
- IV. Have 1-1 or small group sessions to listen and broaden feedback.
