Where Do We Go from Here?

Class on 4th Level Begins Oct 2

Recently, the elders and staff spent a day together to talk about the future of MX Church in a post-COVID, post-Christian world. We recommitted to our values, identified many strengths, recognized many challenges, and could see lots of opportunities!

Related to the priorities we identified, we want to broaden our input and invite you to be in conversation with us.

- How do we strengthen our relationships with one another?
- How do we focus even better on the next generation?
- How do we develop our ministries and leaders?
- How do we better reach out to our community?

We would like to see a broad intergenerational range of men and women working on these questions together. We will be offering a time during Bible Class, beginning Oct 2, called - Where Do We Go from Here? My prayer is that it will be full of lively dialogue, be upbeat, and be led by the Holy Spirit. We will meet during Bible Class at tables on the 4th floor. Led by Jeff and the Elders.

October 2 and 9 - 7 Values at MX

- Spirit-Led (prayerfully following the direction of God)
- Next Gen (investing in the next generation)
- Family (having a common Father to deeply love one another)
- Diversity (sharing in our oneness; appreciating our differences)
- Adaptable (changing to better honor God)
- Generosity (eagerly giving time, talent, and treasure)
- Missional (purposefully sharing the good news as we go)

Our 7 Values describe our vision of ourselves - who we aspire to be as the body of Christ at MX. Our desire is that our priorities, then our ministries, and finally all of our words and actions derive from these values. The values provide a useful lens through which we can evaluate all that we say and do.

- A newcomer to MX asks for your help. Explain to them the meaning of your the value assigned to you using both Scripture and practical examples.
- In what ways can you see the importance of this value to MX?

- In what ways do the 7 Values help us carry out our mission to "welcome others into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ"?
- Give examples of how we might embed these values into everything we say and do at MX?
- Consider how a ministry (Greeters, Worship, Children's Ministry, Food Pantry, etc.)
 might be informed and strengthened through the 7 Values.

October 16 - How do we strengthen our relationships with one another?

One key priority the Elders identified is our sense of community and connections to one another.

Some churches see the main task of the leadership as "creating contagious" environments.

Brainstorm how we might strengthen our relationships. Identify two categories of ministries:

- 1. Ad Hoc Efforts and Events

- 2. Connect Groups and Huddle Groups
- 3. Fellowship Ministry
- 4. Men's Ministry
- 5. Women's Ministry
