 - It will be hard to replace Dolores and Jeannie
 - Youth & Children's minister will have 20% misc responsibilities can help in various ways
 - DW: Dolores encourage her to continue in Jan 2023 as a volunteer (similar to Steve Awtrey). Giver Dolores 3-months of notice to transition her work.
 - DW: Jeannie give her 3-months of notice to find something. Let her know we are phasing out position and she has time to transition duties and look for something else.
 - BS: What happens if Elizabeth leaves?
 - Steve & Steve to get a timeline
 - JK: We need to make decisions and not stay in limbo land

 - Unsure about the class on Sunday as Wesley didn't engage the youth.
 - Likes Wesley's doubts as a HS freshman might be able to relate to the teens
 - Consumerism/Volunteerism "a church driven by consumerism is destined to die." Wesley may encounter some of this at MX.
- Keaton Jones
 - thought Wesley did well. A bright young man.
 - Worried the kids were not engaged
- Dave Weiler
 - Thought Wesley showed well
 - Class curious about how he taught the class and we got a lesson. Wesley CAN teach
 - Wesley is transparent talked about his doubts and return
- Steve Awtrey
 - Worried about the format "we put him in the lion's den"
 - Steve has heard *if we have a good candidate pick one*
- Brad Stevens
 - Feels Wesley has a great set of talents
 - \circ $\;$ Wesley and Nathan are BOTH high energy and good candidates
- Jeremiah Haywood
 - Wesley loves the lord
 - Wesley loved/enjoys the kids
 - Wesley articulated and though through the questions and responded well
- Bret
 - I am sure some will find fault that there wasn't much dialog between students, or small group time, or more talking about feelings, or "fun" ice breakers, etc. We gave Wesley less than an hour and he can't show all the ways he would teach the youth but that doesn't mean he wouldn't or couldn't.
 - \circ Overall impressed with Wesley, both the class and the interview
 - No reservations on Wesley as a viable MX Youth Minister

Sat Oct 1 @ 9:00 am all Elders and Search Committee meet and share individually. Meet with Committee one at a time. Make a decision Sat and call winning candidate that evening. Announce decision Oct 2 (if candidate does not need to wait or needs time before made public).

At 8:00 pm Brad Stevens requested that any staff be dismissed for an elder-only discussion

A point of order – the agenda should be respected and any deviation should be discussed with the meeting chair prior to meeting. Surprise guests or topics should be avoided.

Per Bret, there are two main goals to the Elder meetings, shown in order of importance:

- 1. Meetings should not go beyond 2-hours (with 1 ½ hours preferable)
- 2. Meetings should further God's work in and through MX church

Bret does not feel #2 can be done without addressing #1.

Brad requested special session to discuss staffing holistically, especially Senior Minister and Family & Worship Minister. Specific concerns:

- Expense: These 2 positions account for over \$200,000 of annual budget. Suggested volunteer replacement.
- Staff Conflict: Brad worries that these individuals may be the source of conflict or at a minimum not able to address conflict in the office.
 - Special concern about Family & Worship Minister

The rest of the Elders agreed on the following:

- Jeff Kryder is a gifted preacher who will be phasing out over the next couple of years. Attempting to modify the preaching at MX is considered the nuclear option that will surely do more harm than good. The following was discussed/recommended:
 - Jeff Kryder will be responsible for the ministry and office staff at MX. This is a practical decision as we have no one to backfill and take on this responsibility. In January 2023 Steve A and Steve W may have the bandwidth to assist but will discuss at that time.
 - Steve A and Steve W will work with Jeff K when possible to assist with staff and counsel on interactions (be more receptive to alternative thoughts from staff).
 - Goal is for Jeff Kryder to focus on Preaching, Teaching, Leadership Development
- Jeremy Picker is a good brother with many skills (gifts) and a desire to serve the MX body.
 - Elders to make sure Jeremy has boundaries and clarity of new responsibilities when a Youth Minister is hired.
 - Accountability performance should periodically be reviewed against expectations as described in job description.
- We need clear and frequent frank evaluations with Jeff and Jeremy on how they are doing. I think Steve A and Steve W can provide this feedback in a positive constructive fashion that is not taken as confrontational.
- As elders we need to encourage and support those in ministry here at McKnight
- There is some friction/disfunction amongst the McKnight staff that needs to be addressed. When and how is still a matter of discussion.
