Sunday | Dec 10

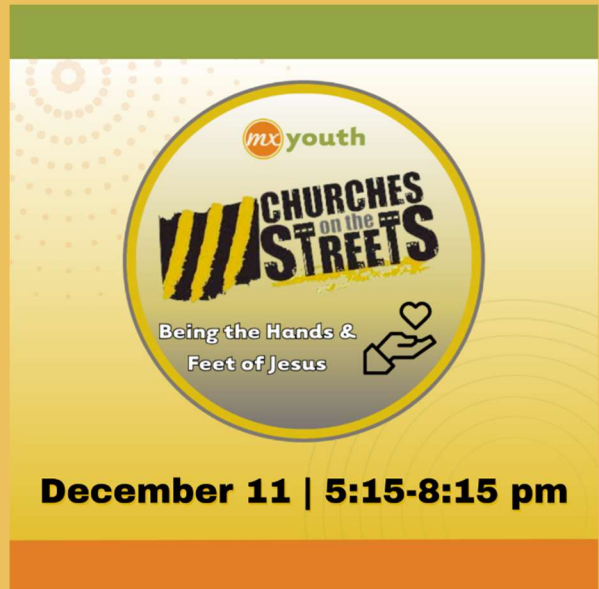
This Sunday we'll finish our 2 part series about the King of Humility. We'll wrap up 2023 Sunday Bible classes with this and return to the Gospel Project in January.
