Discussion on Jeff's Retirement

Elders have met with Jeff Kryder and discussed plans and tentative timeline for retirenment and new minister search. The thought is to inform the congregation sooner than later. NO need to wait for Jeff's 64th birthday in November.

- October 10, 2023 Jeff Kryder to inform staff of his retirement
- October 24, 2023 announcement to the congrgation of Jeff Kryder's retirement in August 2024.
- October 24, 2023 after announcement to congregation will start the "soft search" for any potential candidates
 - Ready to hire asap and have overlap with Jeff Kryder and new minister if God blesses us with suitable candidate early.

Current Building Projects

1. Auditorium Stage

After 50+ years the main auditorium stage will be given a refresh. The hanging boxes will be removed, the vertical wood slats will be removed, the back wall will have new drywall installed and everything will be painted. The lights and HVAC ductwork that was in the hanging boxes will be moved to a new soffit. Estimate of \$10,000.00

2. Parking Lots

The main asphalt parking lot is at least 50 years old and in need of some repair. In previous years we have resurfaced at 4-year intervals. However, the repairs are more serious and need attention. We plan to have repairs made in 2023. Estimate of \$45,000.00

At our last meeting i brought up the concern that i wanted the message to be authentic, meaning that I didn't want to wait until my birthday in late November and then tell the congregation that I will be retiring in the next year implying that I will "step down as a minister before November of 2024", when we all know that I will be finished by August.

However, I am not convinced the fix is to tell the staff and church "very soon" as we are just now embarking upon fall plans / activities (Worship in Park, Job Fair, early 2024 Planning, Fall Classes, as well as numerous building and grounds projects that need to be communicated).

Here's my thought to move things out just a few weeks. I will talk to the staff in mid October, presumably October 10. I will then inform the church on Oct 24, letting them know that I will be finished by the end of August of next year.

After Jeff has talked with the staff we will want to understand the timing of communicating with the congregation.

Last night we agreed that earlier is better for announcing Jeff's retirement to the congregation. Originally we had thought to make the announcement in November, around Jeff's birthday, but after consideration do not think that waiting is necessary.

When and who? Although we talked about making the announcement soon we never settled on a date or who would make the announcement. We tossed around one of the elders or Jeff making the announcement but never settled on who. I think either Don Fitz or Jeff Kryder would be a good choice. I think we are ready for the announcement as soon as Don and/or Jeff Kryder feel ready to make the announcement.

We would like the staff - Elizabeth, Kaylynn, Jeremiah, Nathan - to hear about it before the congregation. We trust the staff to keep this secret until the congregational announcement and I think we are comfortable with Jeff Kryder informing the staff when he feels best.

Congregational Meeting. We decided that a congregational meeting might be a good idea sometime after the announcement of Jeff's retirement. It was decided that it should not be the same day as the announcement and does not even need to be soon.
