Our teen group was a huge blessing, and made my multiple roles a joy. Four of our teens were baptized, and all of them were eager learners and great participants.

I was overseeing director for the 50 teens, and Jeremiah Hostetter did a great job in his role as director in training (in France the director certification takes 4 years). I also oversaw the work crew (kitchen cleaning, laundry, upkeep).

But without a doubt, my greatest joy at camp this year was being a counsellor to my room of 8 awesome teenage guys! What a treat! Our evening devos always went into overtime. God was at work in a mighty way!











A special joy with the baptisms this year was the role the fathers played. After Philippe baptized **Juliette** (a friend of his daughter Aurélia) who lives near the church, Christophe (from near Avignon) baptized his son **Adam**, then former CEMiste Canden from Mauritius baptized his daughter **Ella**, before Philippe baptized his daughter **Aurélia**.

Our staff of over 40 adults worked tirelessly and joyfully together to share the Good News of God's love with our 93 campers. Next year we will celebrate 30 years of Harmony Bible Camp!

9th Biannual Pitman Mission Week




