- 1. Can you tell us about your relationship with Jesus?
 - When did you enter a relationship with Him?
 - What are some things you are doing to grow in your faith?
- 2. Can you share your thoughts on baptism?
- 3. Can you describe your prayer life?
- 4. Have you had occasions where you taught the gospel to someone in a one-on-one Bible study?
 - If so, can you share how the study came about and the results?
 - If not, do you have a plan to develop as an evangelist?
- 5. What do you envision are the top three responsibilities of a lead minister?
- 6. Who are some of the people that have influenced your thinking? Can you give some examples?
- 7. Can you give us an idea of the type of Elder and lead minister relationship structure that works for you?
- 8. Have you had an opportunity to counsel someone who was transitioning to the next life?
 - If so, w/o compromising any confidential information, can you describe the experience?
 - If not, can you describe a situation where you counseled someone who was going through a crisis?
- 9. Tell us about a time you disagreed with someone in a church environment?
 - Can you describe some of the details of the disagreement?
 - How did you handle the situation?
- 10. Can you define the following and share any thoughts and experiences you have with all three?
 - **Church Missions**
 - Diversity
 - **Next Generation Ministry**
- 11. What are your thoughts on preaching on current social issues?

Many issues of concern for various individuals and groups:

- Climate change / environmentalism
- War in Ukraine
- War in Israel
- Vegetarianism and animal rights
- LGBTQ+
- **US** politics
- Racial injustice
- Public health (stroke, heart attacks, diabetes, etc.)

- 12. What is the purpose of Sunday service and what is most important?
- 13. What question have we not asked you that you would like us to ask of you?
- 14. Where would you place yourself on the introvert extrovert spectrum?
- 15. Who are your primary relationships helping you be accountable and "on-track"?
- 16. Share one or two areas of your life where you know you need to grow.²
