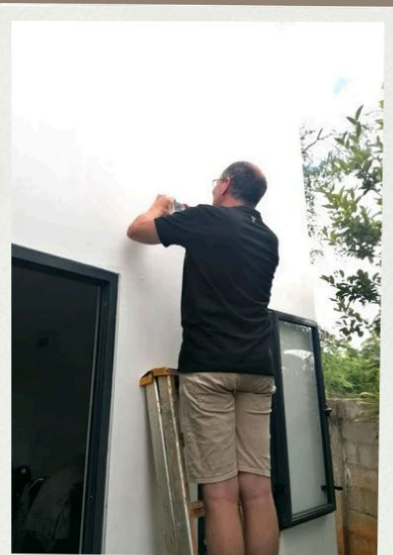
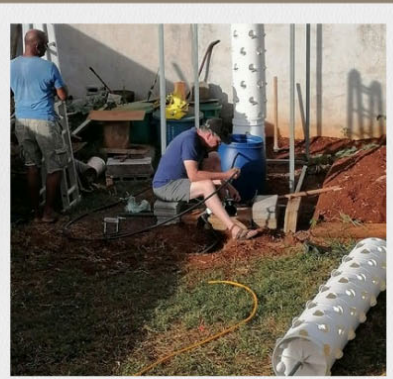
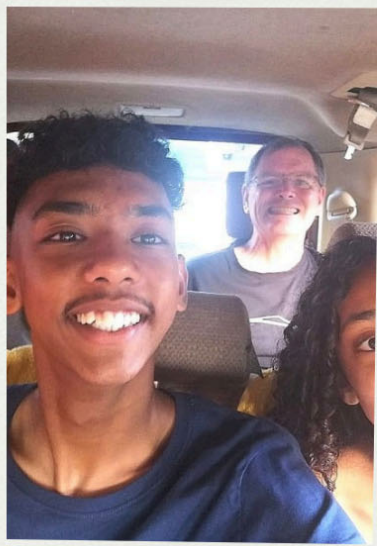
The Youths Retreat @our place
